Supplemental Regulations

1. These are spectator events and will be conducted in strict compliance with the 2006 General Competition Rules and Amendments, except as modified by these Supplemental Regulations. The Stewards of the Meeting reserve the right to alter the schedule for good and sufficient reason.
2. Driver Eligibility-All drivers must have a current /valid SCCA National license and a current SCCA membership. Any driver who is in the process of renewal, or needs confirmation of such, must contact the Chief Registrar prior to 9:00PM, Thursday before the event for National Office verification. A \$5 fee will be charged for this service.
3. The entry fee includes one driver and three crew members. Additional crew and or guest passes may be purchased for \$10 each at Registration. No passes will be sold unless the driver has specified the crew or guest's name. A \$30 collection fee will be added for any check refused for any reason. For the early fee, the entry, with payment enclosed, must be postmarked on or before the August 3, 2006. All credit card payments will be processed on the Wednesday evening before the event. Cancellations, accepted up to 9:00PM on the Thursday before the event, will receive a full refund. All cancellations must be followed up with written confirmation postmarked no later than one day after the event. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days of the event.
4. NO SHOW, NO CANCELLATION = NO REFUND.
5. Pets are ONLY allowed in the **OUTER** paddock and camping areas.
6. National numbers will be held until July 31, 2006. You will be notified ONLY if you do NOT receive your first number choice.
7. There are no waived tech classes for 2006. If you have had an Annual Technical Inspection (with no notations in your logbook from the time of the Annual Technical Inspection), you only need to bring your logbook, helmet, gear and Technical Inspection Sheet to the Technical Inspection Building. If you need an annual technical inspection, please contact the Chief Scrutineer, Chris Peet at (269-963-0602) or repeat68racing@aol.com in advance so we can minimize your wait time.
8. The top three finishers in each class must report to impound at the conclusion of their race. Competition vehicles may be impounded during and or after practice, qualifying or the race at the discretion of the Chief Steward or Chief Scrutineer. The driver must remain with the vehicle at impound.
9. The false grid will close at the one-minute signal. Once the false grid is closed, all track entrances must be done through pit lane. The false grid must be cleared of all crew at the one-minute signal.
10. Unless modified by the Official Schedule, no races engines may be started from 6:00PM to 9:00AM.
11. Operational AMB TranX260 transponders are mandatory for all sessions of this event.
12. The use of any motorized or non-motorized, two, three or four wheeled vehicle is permitted. Operation of motorized vehicles requires a valid drivers license, and non-motorized operators must be at least 12 years of age. No roller or in-line skates or skateboards are permitted. Check with track authorities regarding safety equipment required for after hours bicycling on the track. Riding on exterior coachwork is not permitted.
13. Trophies will be awarded per GCR or better. See driver packet given at registration for more information. Trophies and Official results will be available at Driver Information when the results are official. Driver Information is located beside the Technical Inspection Building. Provisional qualifying and race results will be posted on the Timing Tower. Sound readings will be posted at Technical Inspection Building.
14. The following are track radio frequencies: 151.625, 151.925, 154.600 and 154.640MHz. Other radio transmissions are prohibited on these frequencies.
15. Camping is available for a \$20 fee. Fuel, water and compressed air are available at the track. There is a \$20 disposal fee for each tire left at the track. The concession stand is open for breakfast at 8:00AM.
16. Friday practice is a track activity and NOT sanctioned by WMR or the SCCA.
