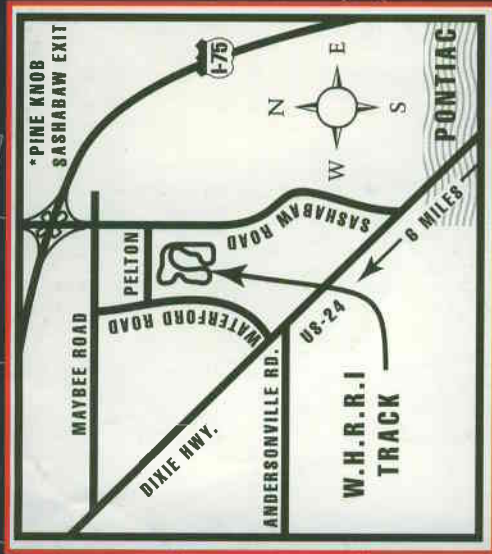

WELCOME RACE FANS

Did you know there is a race track "in your own backyard"? It is the Waterford Hills Road Racing Track--tucked away in the hills of Clarkston, Michigan on the grounds of the Oakland County Sportsmen's Club. Those of us already enjoying "the best kept secret" in Oakland County would like to share this exciting value in family entertainment with you.

START YOUR ENGINES

We invite you to "race on out" with your friends and family this summer to see what you have been missing! Chances are you live within a short drive of the Midwest's premier road-race course. The Waterford Hills Race Track is located in Clarkston, MI--just 6 miles North of Pontiac on Waterford Road, 1/4 mile East of Dixie Hwy. (US24). From I-75 exit at Sashabaw Road then South to Pelton Road West which ends at Waterford Road. Go South a short distance and you are at the track--only 2.5 miles from I-75!

GET IN GEAR

Be sure to mark your race calendar so you don't miss any of the action! Six full weekends of racing are held each summer. Races are scheduled for the last full weekend of the month from May thru September with an additional weekend (generally the first weekend in May).

The gates open at 9:00 a.m. for viewing of the practice laps beginning promptly at 10:00 a.m. with all qualifying and racing action immediately following on Saturday and again on Sunday - -- RAIN or SHINE!



AND THEY'RE OFF

The green flag has dropped on many races at Waterford Hills since 1958! Over the past four decades Waterford Hills Road Racing, Inc. (W.H.R.R.I.) has promoted the competitive sport of live, action packed road racing not only for the enjoyment of it's member--but also for the viewing pleasure of thousands of Midwest racing fans. HIGH SPEED THRILLS

You will be amazed and impressed with the driving skills developed for the safe and successful navigation of this mile-and-a-half ribbon of smooth black top! The thirteen right and left hand turns twist up and down hills like no other race course in the United States. Spectators actually "feel" the roar as sedans, sports cars, and formula cars fly by--locked in fierce wheel-to-wheel competition racing for the thrill of the checkered flag!

Many of the top Waterford drivers have gone on to become U.S. and Canadian Champions, professional drivers, and road rallyists! Some even have "groupies" that follow and cheer their exploits every race weekend! Beyond all that W.H.R.R.I. is a year round organization of racing enthusiasts that enjoy the fun and fraternity of the Midwest's most exciting racing club. Not only is the competition close, but so are the friendships that develop during the full year of races, club meetings and social events.

W.H.R.R.I. DRIVERS SCHOOL

To qualify for a racing license, W.H.R.R.I. members must be at least 18 years of age, and must have successfully completed a recognized Race Driving School. The W.H.R.R.I. school includes personal instruction in the classroom and on the track. Our competition driving school is one of the most comprehensive and highly respected schools in the country.

Your car must also be outfitted for road racing to pass a technical and safety inspection based on the General Competition Rules. For personal safety, drivers need a fire-resistant Nomex driving suit, shoes, gloves, and a Snell-approved crash helmet.
